Utility Burden	Households with Above Average, High, or Severe Energy Burden	Energy Burden is the percent of median yearly income that households pay for electricity and gas bills. Households nationally on average pay about 3% of their income on energy bills. A household that pays more than 6% of their income on energy bills is considered to have high energy burden, while a household that pays more than 10% is considered to be have severe energy burden. These indicators show the number of households with energy burdens above the 3% national average, the 6% threshold for high energy burdened, or the 10% threshold for severe energy burden across different census tracts.
